AU Teacher Education Bridge Program Admission Requirements

Formal admission into the Teacher Education Bridge Program is separate from admission to Augusta University. Only applicants who satisfy the following criteria will be considered for admission into the BSED in Elementary Education and Middle Grades Educator Preparation Programs.

Applying for Admission to Augusta University:

- 1. Follow course curriculum outlined on advising track sheet. Be sure to check for any additional courses required by Augusta University and the Teacher Education program.
- 2. Apply for admission as a transfer student to Augusta University. The minimum admission requirements are completion of 30 transferrable hours with at least a 2.3 cumulative GPA. Application deadlines for admission to Augusta University are listed below.

Spring Semester: December 1st Summer Semester: April 1st Fall Semester: July 1st

3. Once admitted to Augusta University and before applying to the Teacher Education program, follow the next steps included in the acceptance packet (which includes information regarding orientation, financial aid and campus housing). The AU Academic Advisement Center advisor cannot begin

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working with students until students have been accepted, scheduled orientation and had initial registration contact with your AU advisor.

4. You will receive additional instructions from your AU Academic Advisor about completion of the Teacher Education application and your course registration process.

Applying for Admission to Teacher Education:

It is suggested that you complete steps 1-4 above prior to completing the following steps. Taking the GACE prior to applying to the Teacher Education Program will allow time for your scores to be received and viewed. Documents and scores submitted or received after the Teacher Education deadline are not guaranteed review for a decision.

- <u>Create or update</u> your GACE ETS account and your MyPSC account on the <u>Georgia Professional</u> <u>Standards Commission</u> website. Be sure to choose Augusta University as your program provider and select "or program admissions" as your reasoning for testing. There are additional instructions on these websites to create your accounts and to connect the two accounts together. Please use those instructions as guides for these accounts.
- 2. Register for the Georgia Educator Ethics Assessment and the GACE Program Admissions Assessment through your new accounts. Approximately two days after you create the accounts, you will receive a testing link from ETS to register to take the Georgia Educator Ethics Exam. This will allow you to both pay and complete the assessment. BOTH GACE ASSESSMENTS ARE HIGHLY RECOMMENDED TO BE COMPLETED BY THE FIRST SEMESTER OF YOUR SOPHOMORE YEAR.
- 3. Complete the Georgia Educator Ethics Assessment (350) through your GACE and MyPSC portal. At the end of the assessment, you need to print the completion certificate and add it to the Teacher Education Program application.
- 4. Successful performance scores for the GACE Program Admission Test are listed below. Your scores must place at the professional level to be considered passing scores.

Reading: 250 or higher Math: 250 or higher Writing: 250 or higher

NOTE: Applicants may exempt the GACE Program Admission Test if one of the following is satisfied:

SAT-Scores Prior to July 1, 2019-Composite score of 1000 using Math & Verbal SAT-Scores on or after July 1, 2019-1080 on Evidence-Based Reading/Writing AND Math ACT-Composite score of 43 using Math & English GRE-Composite score of 1030 using Quantitative & Verbal

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5. Complete application for Teacher Education with your AU Academic Advisor. Application deadlines for admission to the Teacher Education program are listed below.

Spring Semester: December 1st Fall Semester: July 1st

- 6. A minimum GPA of a 2.75 (Overall) is required to apply to the Teacher Education Program. Admissions into Teacher Education requires successful completion of the following courses:
 - a. Completion of Augusta University Bridge Program. All applicants must complete EDN 216 (EDUC 2110), EDN 226 (EDUC 2120), and EDN 236 (EDUC 2130) before entering the program.
- 7. A record free of criminal and disciplinary problems.
